<p><b>TF-NTU LEaRN</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Open to nationals of member countries of ASEAN, China and India (except Singapore) to pursue a semester of coursework at NTU.</li> <li>• Applicants must be a full-time Undergraduate student in one of NTU exchange partner institutions.</li> <li>• Have completed 2 semesters of study at home university, with proof of results.</li> <li>• NTU will only review student applications that are nominated and formally submitted to NTU International Relations Office (IRO) by the exchange coordinators of exchange partner universities.</li> <li>• Each NTU partner institutions <b>should not submit more than five (5) applications</b>, unless otherwise indicated, for NTU's review.</li> <li>• <b>Each nominee should be from different faculty/schools.</b></li> <li>• Applicants should possess the following:               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) An excellent academic record - within the top 5% of cohort</li> <li>b) A very good command of the English Language</li> <li>c) Hold leadership positions in any of university student activity clubs (to list in 200-word letter)</li> </ol> </li> <li>• Student to submit a 200-word letter on why he/she deserves to be part of the <b>LEaRN</b> programme.</li> <li>• A Recommendation Letter from faculty of host institution and an outline of a CV of the nominee's</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• More than <b>50 LEaRN</b> grants will be awarded in Ay2008/09 Semester 2 (Jan – May 2009).</li> <li>• Each <b>LEaRN</b> grant is tenable for an academic semester only or up to 6 months at NTU in Singapore.</li> <li>• Each <b>LEaRN</b> grant shall cover the following:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➢ Full Tuition fee</li> <li>➢ Stipend for the semester: up to S\$4,000 (includes air fare, living allowance and hostel fees)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• E-Applications open on <b>October 1, 2008</b> and close on <b>October 20, 2008.</b></li> <li>• <b><u>Online Application</u> by Mon, October 20, 2008</b></li> <li>• <b>We no longer require your office to send us the Original Application Documents.
